- **St Andrew's School Supporters' Association regularly raise money for our school**

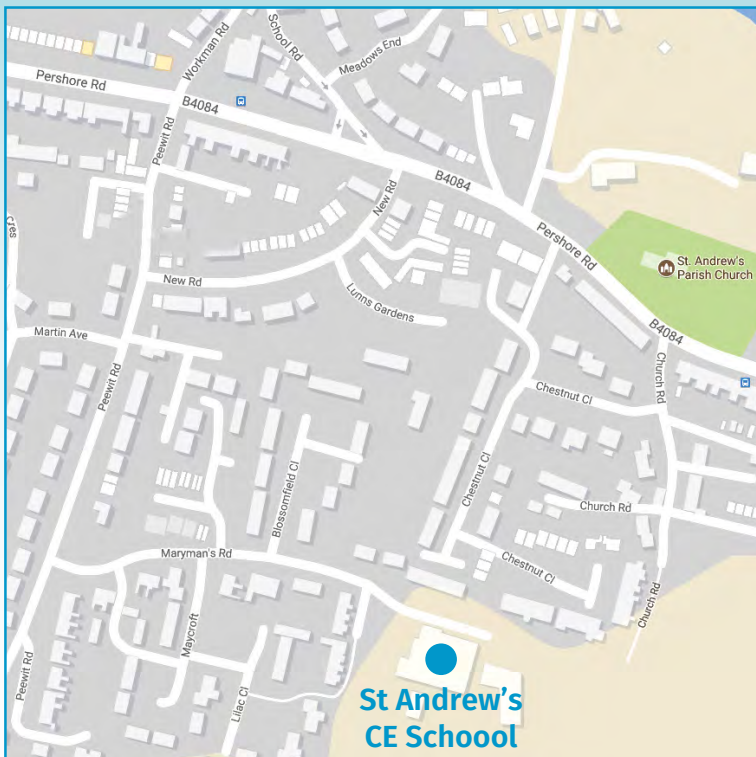

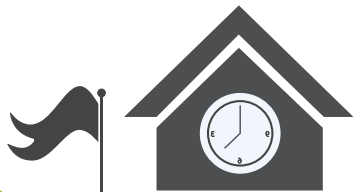
