Our classes

- At St. Andrew's we have two classes in each year group – this year we expect to have 19/20 children in each class. In Reception we work as a unit for much of the day, with the children from each class playing and learning together in the garden and Seedlings classroom. Quiet, focused 1:1 or group work, such as reading and writing are done in Pippins classroom.
- We stay in our class groups for focused learning times.
- Each year the classes will be mixed as they move into their new year group.



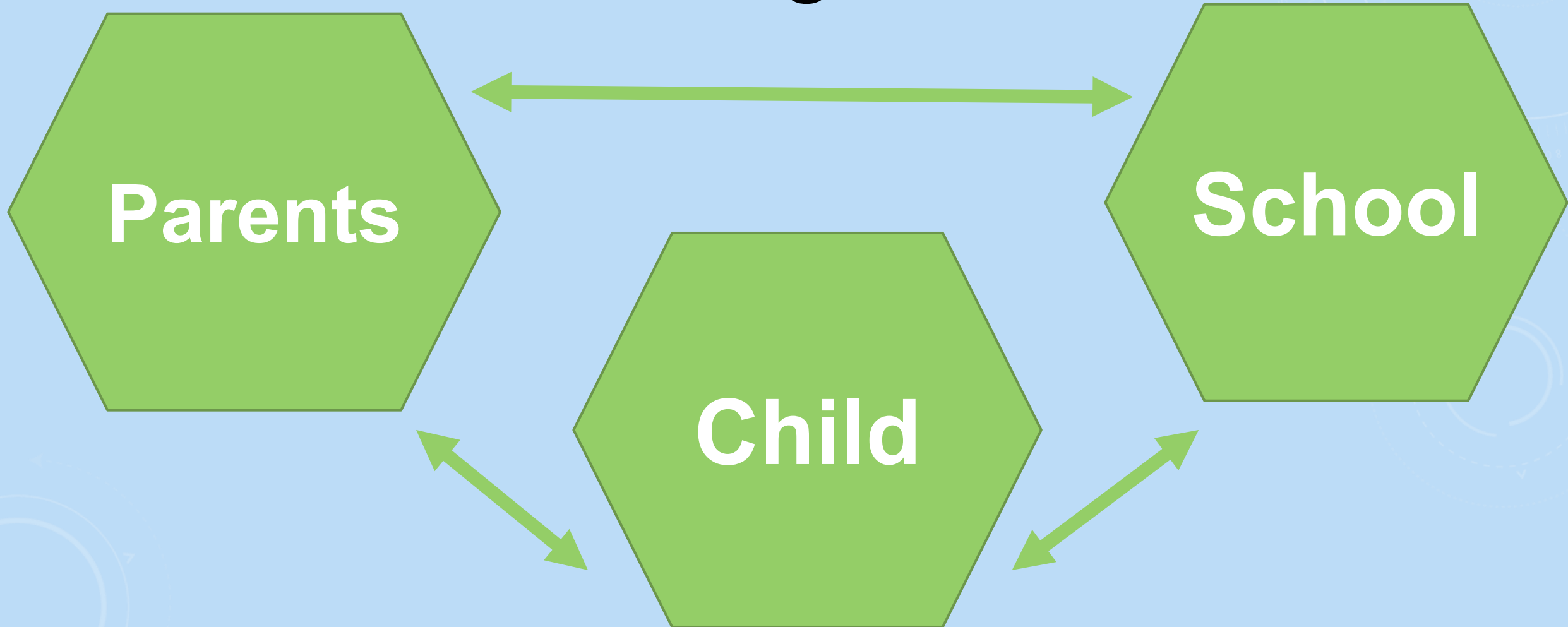

- Phonics each morning at 9am
- Whole class activities – phonics, maths, literacy
- Choosing time – with adults supporting learning through play both inside and outside.
- Focused learning – 1:1 or small group learning
- PE once a week
- Forest school once a week
- Trips and visits

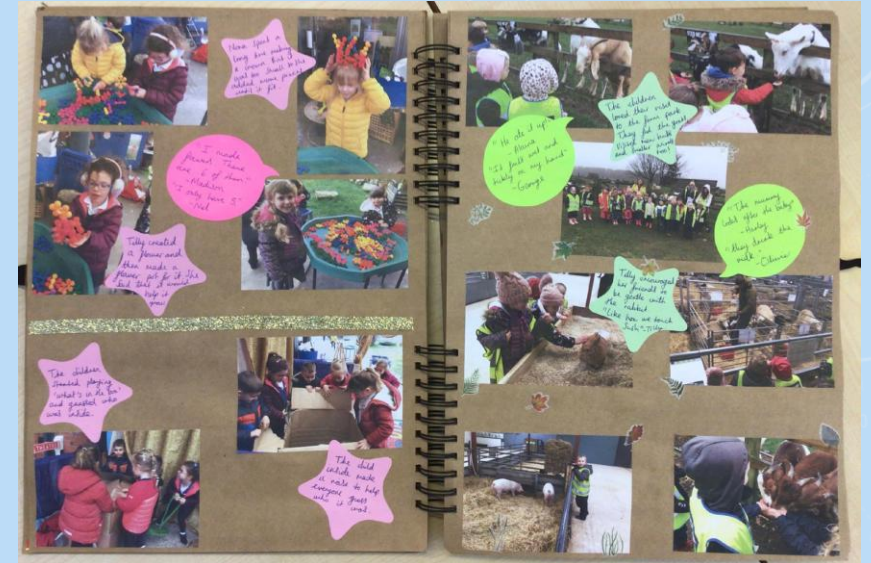

Our Learning

- We use writing books and class 'floor books' to evidence our learning in school.
- Each activity is linked to a learning objective that we want the children to achieve. We document the children's thoughts on their learning too.
- You will get an opportunity to see the floor books at parents evenings and during Link and Learn sessions.



Class Dojo



- Class Dojo is an online system
- We can share class photos of what we are doing to keep you informed about our learning
- Your child has their very own avatar which collects points during the week for following our school values such as trying their best, giving challenges a go and being kind and respectful



School Uniform

We ask that children have at least one logoed item – a cardigan or sweatshirt.

- logoed royal blue sweatshirt/fleece/cardigan
- royal blue or white polo shirt
- gingham or striped dress (blue and white)
- grey or black trousers/skirt/pinafore dress
- plain black shoes
- dark plain socks (boys); white or dark plain socks or tights (girls)
- logoed book bag (please ensure your child brings theirs in every day)

PE Kit

- Blue shorts
- Royal blue or white T-shirt
- Bare feet when indoors
- Trainers when outdoors
- Plain tracksuit (during winter months)
- PE draw string bag (for summer term)
- Reception children come in dressed in their PE kit ready until Summer Term

School uniform

The PTFA are selling second-hand uniform for very reduced prices today!

You can pay by cash or card.

TOP TIP – Buy a size bigger so that it still fits by the end of the year. This helps the children to dress and undress independently.



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Snack time

If snack is brought from home, please put it in a labelled tub and make sure it is healthy – crackers, cereal bar, dried fruit, cheese etc





Lunch

- Lots of lunch time staff are there to help your child.
- New safe eating guidelines – children in the early years shouldn't have popcorn or marshmallows. Food should be cut into strips rather than balls/cubes and large stones should be removed from fruit. Children are supervised closely while eating.
- Please provide your child with a packed lunch for the first few weeks of school until access to the booking system is set up. Children will be able to have a school lunch from Monday 21st September.
- All children receive a free meal up until the end of Year 2. You can still apply for 'Free School Meal' funding if your income is below a certain threshold. The pupil premium money can be used to support your child in other ways. Please ask the office staff for more information .





The children will start full time straight away

- Children can come into school from 8:45am and the morning register will be taken by 9:00am. Punctuality is very important as we do the most important learning first thing when the children are most attentive. School then finishes at 3:15pm.
- At home time - please collect your child from the Reception garden doors by Seedlings class. There is a strict policy on collection of your child. Please ring the office if there are any changes to the person who is collecting your child from school.

Wrap Around Care - WAC

- This is on a pre-booking system
- Arrive at 7:45am onwards
- A range of hot or cold breakfasts. Reception and Key Stage 1 children are escorted to their classrooms at 8.45am
- After school club is from 3.15pm until 6pm
- All children are collected from their classrooms and taken to the on-site provision
- They are offered a healthy snack and a range of activities to try

What do I need to do now?

- Make sure relevant forms have been given back to the office
- Update medications ready for September – please ask your GP to provide an inhaler/EpiPen to be kept at school if your child needs it ready for the first day
- Ask questions if you are unsure of anything! We want the transition to be as smooth for you as it is for your child.



What do I need to do now?

- Register for an account with SchoolScreeners in order to access the Parent Portal for hearing and eye screening results once your child starts school.
- Talk to the school nurse team if you have any concerns or questions.

How to help your child to become 'school ready'

- Make sure your child can dress themselves for school
- Encourage them to go to the toilet by themselves
- Practise focusing on activities like colouring, jigsaws, lego building, board games etc.
- Talk positively about school experiences. Reassure your child. Use the transition booklet to build familiarity with adults and the environment



How to help your child once they start school

- Read, read and read some more
- Let them talk about their day in their own time
- Talk to the staff about any concerns you have
- Come along to parents evenings, workshops, Link and Learn sessions
